If a supervisor and supervisee are not employed within the same agency, there must be a written plan filed with the board

Examination: Advanced Generalist

Experience: 24 months within 24 to 36 months; 1000

direct client contact hours; 100 hours under direct supervision; minimum of 1 hour per week; minimum 75 hours face to face with supervisor; maximum of 25 hours distance supervision; maximum 25 hours of group supervision; maximum group size of 5; approved supervisor: Licensed Certified Social Worker or Licensed Certified Social Worker-Macro pre-approved by the Board. If a supervisor and supervisee are not employed within the same agency, there must be a written plan filed with the board
